Served as the Executive Director (1995-97) and Director of Research (1999-2003) of the *International Institute of Islamic Thought (IIIT)*, Editor of *the Journal of Islamic Social Sciences* (1999-2003), and President of the *Association of Muslim Social Scientists* (1999-2003).

Also served as an Associate Professor of Political Science (1994-99), Dean of Research (1998-99), and Senate Member at the International Islamic University, Malaysia (1995-99). Also served as Visiting Professor at George Washington University (2001).

Participated in numerous international forums and conferences, and contributed articles to various academic journals, including *the American Journal of Islamic Social Sciences*, *Islamic Studies*, *Intellectual Discourse*, *Middle East Affairs Journal*, *Journal of Middle Eastern and South Asian Studies*, *Islamiyyat al-Maʿrifa*, *al-Mustaqbal al-Arabi*, *Minbar al-Hiwar*, *al-Insan*, and *al-Muslim al-Muʿasir*.
